#### **ST LEONARD'S WELCOMES CHILDREN!**

On Sunday mornings there is something for every child at St Leonard's:

- On the **first Sunday** we all worship together, and the service is especially considerate to our younger members.
- **Pre-schoolers - The Play Room!**  
We have a lovely well-equipped playroom at the top of the ramp.  
The service is relayed inside, and you are welcome to use it freely with your toddler at any time during the service.  
We also have a soft play zone at the back - which you can use, and there are highchairs for little ones who want a better view!
- **KS1 Children (yrs R, 1, 2 & 3) – The ground floor Chapel.**
- **KS2 Children (yrs 3, 5 & 6) – The upstairs vestries.**  
School-aged children come to the front when we sing 'The Gloria!', the President prays for them, and they go together to the entrance area and are taken to their group.  
They will magically appear in time for 'The Peace' and will return to you as we greet one another.  
You are welcome to stay with your child to settle them if you wish.
- **Year 7+**  
Our secondary school aged children stay in church helping in lots of different ways. Some help with welcome and hospitality, some are servers, some help with the little ones, some with the tech. If your youngster would like to get involved just let a member of the team know.  
All our children's church volunteers are DBS checked.
