ADVENT COURSE: TRAVELLING LIGHT

We are delighted to be able to offer a four-week Advent course based around readings from the gospels (Luke 1, Matthew 2), with a recurring theme of travel. The Bible is full of comings and goings.

In this Advent course, we come alongside a few of those travellers. We journey with them, reflect with them, almost getting into conversation with them about their experiences.

We hope to find inspiration, to put a spring in our step; explore guidance about the route ahead; and perhaps some warnings which may prompt us to change our own direction of travel.

In all this, we move on – towards the celebration of Christmas and then to the New Year that lies beyond it.
