# THE LITURGY OF THE SACRAMENT

## **The Peace** *please stand*

*The children return and gather at the Chancel steps.*

The risen Christ came and stood among his disciples  
and said, 'Peace be with you.'

Then were they glad when they saw the Lord. Alleluia!

*The children invite us to share a sign of peace*

'Let us offer one another a sign of peace'.

## **Offertory Hymn**

## **The Eucharistic Prayer**

*The president praises God for his mighty acts:*

*The president recalls the Last Supper, and we use this acclamation:*

**Lord, by your cross and resurrection  
you have set us free.  
You are the Saviour of the world.**

*The prayer continues and ends with praise to God to which everyone responds*

**Blessing and honour and glory and power be yours for ever and ever.  
Amen.**

## **The Lord's Prayer** *please sit*
