Saturday 22 January 2022 – what is a Swap Shop?



It is a free and local exchange where members of the public can pass on things they no longer want in exchange for something they need. Other names are “give or take days”, “free for all”, “Freecycle. Participants do not need to bring anything in order to take away goods and vice versa. Swap shops recognise that things no longer wanted by someone might be another person's treasure. By reusing things, we cut down on the amount of waste that goes into landfill and reduce the number of resources that we use in manufacturing of new products.
