



Baritone/Bass Choral Scholarship

2022/23

St Leonard's Church, Streatham seeks to appoint a bass Choral Scholar for the coming academic year (2022/23) to sing with the established choir.

The scholarship would be ideal for a someone currently studying at music college or a young professional musician. Experience of church music and the Anglican choral tradition is useful but not essential, as is sight-reading proficiency. It is an excellent introduction to the London choral scene and provides useful training for those wishing to sing with professional choral ensembles.

The choir rehearses every Thursday evening. The scholar would be expected to assist in leading the choristers' rehearsal, which runs from 6pm to 7.15pm then attend the adult choir rehearsal, which runs from 7.30pm to 9pm. All rehearsals take place in the church. The choir sings Eucharist at 10am every Sunday (9.15am rehearsal) and Evensong at 4.30pm on the 1st, 3rd, and 4th Sundays of every month (3.15pm rehearsal).

The successful candidate will receive an honorarium of £3,000 for the year, paid in three instalments, and will be expected to sing for most Sunday services throughout the academic year (September – July) and at the major festivals such as Christmas and Easter.
