HELPING THOSE WHO STRUGGLE BECAUSE OF THE EXTRA DEMANDS AT CHRISTMAS

Each year at St Leonard's we make special efforts to ease Christmas pressures faced by with very low income. This year your help and generosity is requested in three ways:

1. We want £10 notes to purchase gift tokens (Aldi) for 80 families using the foodbank and Refugee Drop-in Centre(both are in Streatham).
