### **WELCOME TO ST. LEONARD'S!**

We have made every effort today to ensure everyone's safety. We have displayed our Risk Assessment for services on the notice board in the Narthex if you would like to see it. Please follow the guidance below to help us keep services safe for everyone.

#### **COVID SAFETY STEPS**

##### **FACE COVERING**

For those who are able, it is a requirement to wear a face covering for worship. If you are unable for health reasons you are warmly welcome to attend services, but we would ask that you sit in an especially socially distanced space if you are not wearing a mask.

##### **TOILETS**

Toilets are available on request only. Please speak to a sidesperson if you need to use the facilities.

##### **CASH FOR COLLECTION**

We would ask that you donate contactless via the machine in the narthex. However, if this is not possible then please leave cash donations in the collection box on the font.

##### **COMMUNION ONE WAY SYSTEM**

If you would like to receive communion please wait in your seat until a sidesperson calls you. Then please follow the one-way system to maintain social distancing rules.

##### **LEAVING THE BUILDING**

We would ask that you leave the building after the service in an orderly fashion and maintaining 2 metres distance where possible. Please feel free to catch up and be social in the churchyard, maintaining social distancing rules.

##### **REPORTING SYMPTOMS**

IF you develop any new COVID related symptoms (loss of taste, temperature and/or cough) please call 07438895221. Please leave your contact details and the date and time of your visit to the church on the answer machine and someone from the church office will respond to you as soon as possible. You can also check in using our QR code which is pinned up in the Narthex, this will help the NHS assist us in tracking and tracing the virus if it were to come to St. Leonard's.
